ITINERARY

DAY ONE: Arrival New Hampshire ~ Winnepesaukee Scenic Railroad Dinner Train

After an early morning departure, we will head to New Hampshire making our customary rest stop and lunch stops (at your own expense) en route. Upon arrival in Meredith, New Hampshire we'll climb aboard the Winnepesaukee Scenic Railroad for a two-hour train excursion while enjoying a delightful turkey dinner. Following the train ride check into the Mountain Club on Loon Resort, Lincoln, NH for a three (3) night stay. **Meals(s) Dinner.**

DAY TWO: Granite State Railroad Fall Foliage Train ~ Kellerhaus Candies

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll depart with our guide for another day of touring. All aboard for a four-hour Fall Foliage special train departing from Meredith Station, and we'll travel north, up and over Ashland Summit. Enjoy the stunning autumn views crossing the scenic Ashland High Trestle, passing through the Bonnie Brae Deer Farm and the Glove Hollow Christmas Tree Farm. Upon arrival in Plymouth, NH, step off the train for a hot buffet luncheon at the charming Common Man Inn & Spa. After lunch, we'll reboard the train heading south, stopping at the restored 1869 Ashland Railroad Station for a guided tour led by 1860's attired members of the Ashland Historical Society. Continue the train journey with picturesque views of Lake Waukegan as we make our way back to Meredith Station. Next, we'll make a stop at Kellerhaus Candies, a family operated business in the Weirs Beach area of Laconia, NH that makes handmade chocolates, candies, and ice cream from the same recipes since 1906. Tonight, enjoy a delightful dinner at a local restaurant. **Meal(s) Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner**

DAY THREE: White Mountains Touring ~ Cog Railway ~ Lafayette Dinner Train

Following breakfast at the hotel depart for a day of touring with a local guide. Travel through the White Mountains through notches carved out by glaciers, mountain passes and scenic overlooks. You'll hear the history, geology, and the lore of the area. Enjoy a scenic train ride on the Cog Railway to the summit of Mount Washington, the Northeast's Highest Peak! You'll have some free time to take photos or just take in the view before heading back down the mountain. A boxed lunch will be provided. Next, visit Fadden's General Store and Maple Sugarhouse, an authentic old fashioned general store, family owned since 1896! The Fadden family has been producing top quality maple syrup for nearly 200 years and have won numerous awards including 5-time winner of the "Best Maple Syrup in New Hampshire". You'll have free time to browse and shop in this rustic store for souvenirs, and they have the largest selection of maple syrup and maple sugar products.

Tonight, we'll escape the ordinary and relive the romance of dining on the rails on the Café Lafayette Dinner Train. While riding in one of the three beautifully restored Pullman dining cars, enjoy a five-course meal served to you in Grand European manner. As dinner is served, period music keeps time with the rail's rhythmic rumbling, punctuated by the haunting wail of the engine's whistle. After dinner, with the compartment lights down low and the dramatic sunset outside your window, you may allow yourself a wistful romantic journey back in time, and you might wish the evening would never end. After this amazing evening, we will head back to the hotel. **Meal(s) Breakfast, Boxed Lunch, Dinner**
