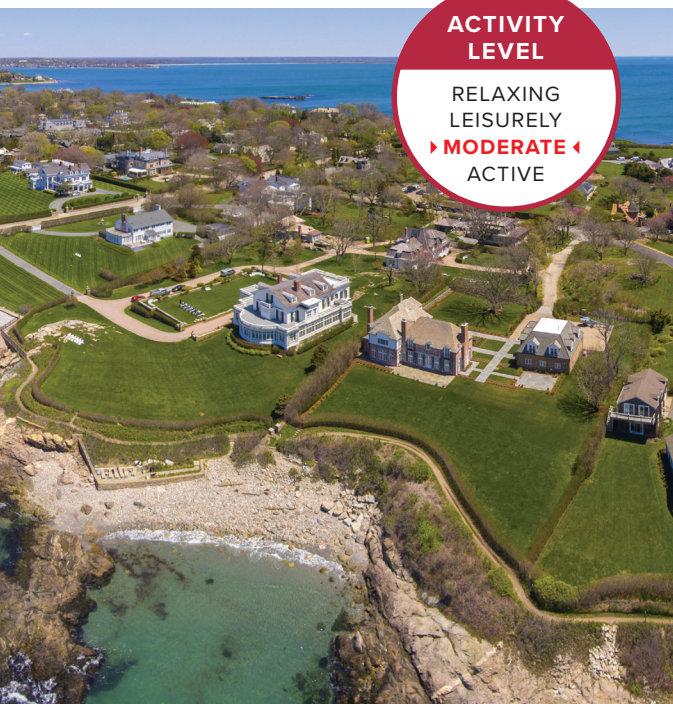
**DAY 1: ARRIVE IN BOSTON, MA** This afternoon, you will be met by your Unique Journeys Tour Director and be transferred by motorcoach to your hotel for an overnight stay. The evening is at leisure and dinner is on your own.

**Holiday Inn Boston – Cambridge Area, Cambridge, MA**

**DAY 2: HISTORIC BOSTON TOUR - PLYMOUTH, MA - CAPE COD, MA** After breakfast at the hotel and check out, say hello to your local guide who will take you on a tour of historic Boston. Among the sights you will see will be Boston Common, the Old State House, the Old North Church, the Old South Meeting House, Beacon Hill and Old Ironsides, and the U.S.S. Constitution. Located in downtown Boston near the waterfront, you'll also visit Faneuil Hall Marketplace before departing for Plymouth, MA. Enjoy a guided tour of historic Plymouth including legendary Plymouth Rock, the Mayflower II, a recreation of the ship that brought the Pilgrims to the New World. Next you will visit Plimoth Patuxet Museums, the living-history experience depicting the Pilgrims' 17th-century village. This evening, check in to your hotel overlooking beautiful Nantucket Sound, for a five-night stay and enjoy a lovely welcome dinner. **B, D** **Red Jacket Beach Resort, Cape Cod, MA**

**DAY 3: MARTHA'S VINEYARD, MA** After breakfast at the hotel, you will take the ferry to the island of Martha's Vineyard. Shaped like a triangle and located just eight-miles off the coast, this island has long been known as a summer hideaway of the rich and famous. Your guide will explain the subtle nuances and diversity of island history, architecture and culture hiding in plain sight. You'll see stately Greek revival homes built by sea captains of long ago, hear stories of notable residents, religious leaders, and political activists, along with meeting houses, cemeteries and other points of interest. You will have time to enjoy an island lunch (at your own expense) and shop for souvenirs before taking the ferry back to the mainland. **B** **Red Jacket Beach Resort, Cape Cod, MA**

**DAY 4: CHATHAM - CAPE COD NATIONAL SEASHORE - PROVINCETOWN - WHALE WATCHING CRUISE & DUNE TOUR** Following breakfast at the hotel, set out for an exciting day of adventure along the Outer Cape. Begin in Chatham, a charming seaside village beside the Chatham Light near the elbow of the Cape's silhouette. From here you travel along the Cape Cod National Seashore, where spectacular views off the cliffs overlooking the Atlantic Ocean. You'll see the horizon as Thoreau saw it when he wrote "There was nothing but that savage ocean between us and Europe."





This great Outer Beach is now a protected national seashore with 40 miles of pristine beach, marshes, ponds and uplands supporting a diversity of species with lighthouses and wild cranberry bogs lining the way.

Arriving in Provincetown, at the tip of the Cape, you'll have free time to browse the eclectic shops and boutiques and have lunch (at your own expense). Following lunch, enjoy a Whale Watching excursion where a naturalist will narrate the cruise and describe the whales you may see, their behavior and some of the other marine life common to the area. Once your Whale Watching excursion returns to the dock, set out on a new adventure in large four-wheel drive vehicles, with sand dunes stretching as far as you can see. As you travel, your guide will point out the "dune shacks" where famous artists and writers like Eugene O'Neill and Harry Kemp became inspired to create their work. When you return at the end of the day, you'll feast on a traditional Cape Cod lobster dinner at one of the Cape's most popular seafood restaurants. 🚶 B, D 🚗 Red Jacket Beach Resort, Cape Cod, MA

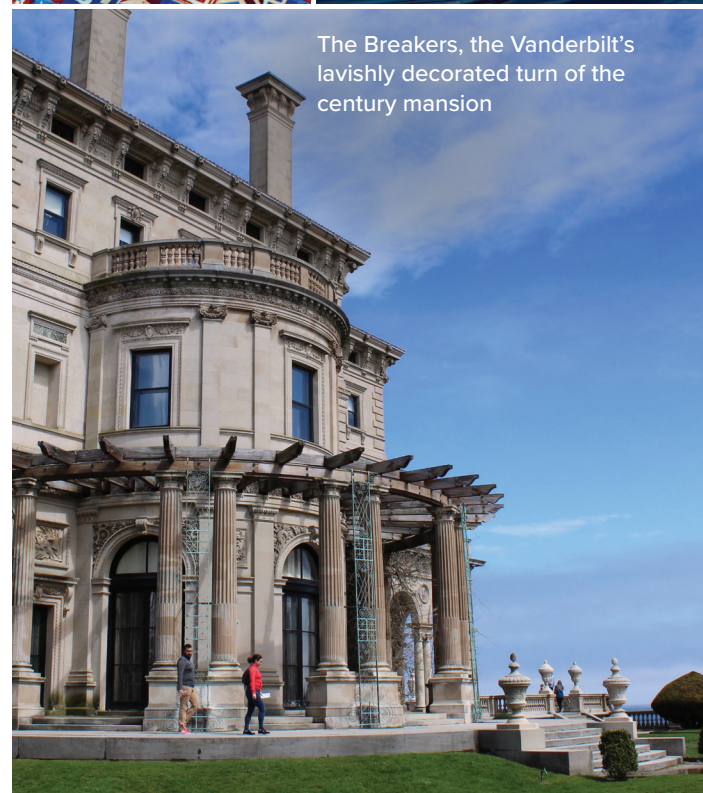


**DAY 5: HYANNIS PORT - JFK MEMORIAL - NANTUCKET ISLAND** After breakfast, enjoy a brief tour of Hyannis Port, home of the Kennedy clan. You will stop by the John F. Kennedy Memorial and Korean War Memorial overlooking Veteran's Beach for a photo op, and then board the high-speed ferry for a cruise to Nantucket. This island is 30-miles southeast of Martha's Vineyard. Fondly known as "The Grey Lady" it is a place of windswept beaches, blinking lighthouses, and offers a charming way of life. Once the world's top whaling port, the island is now a designated National Historic District. Enjoy guided island touring, along with free time to explore, browse the shops, and have lunch on your own. Later this afternoon, you'll cruise back to the mainland, where tonight you will enjoy a delicious dinner and light entertainment. 🚶 B, D 🚗 Red Jacket Beach Resort, Cape Cod, MA

**DAY 6: NEWPORT, RI - THE GILDED AGE MANSIONS** After breakfast, you will travel to Newport, RI, one of New England's most elegant coastal cities. Enjoy a guided tour featuring Newport's scenic Ten Mile Ocean Drive. Then visit The Breakers, the grand seaside "summer cottage" of the Vanderbilt family for a self-guided tour. **Deposit & Final Payment:** Deposit of \$350 per person is due with Reservation Form to secure reservations. Final Payment Due Date is March 25, 2027.

**Important General Information:** The rate is based on a minimum of 30 paying participants.

**Air Gateways:** Roundtrip air transportation – including air taxes, government fees & current fuel surcharges (subject to increase at the discretion of the airline) – is included in the tour rate as listed.

**Name Changes** are not allowed. Each passenger cancellation is processed independently of any new passenger booking.

**Hotels** are subject to change.

**Triple Rates:** Triple room rate reduction is based on a standard double room with 2 beds. Triple rates do NOT include a third rollaway bed.

**Required Travel Documentation:** For travel within the United States, beginning May 2025, a Real ID license or passport is required for air travel within the United States.

**Itinerary:** Itinerary is subject to change. It's very common for the daily activities and people to people interactions & visits to be interchanged and experienced on different days than this printed itinerary. All visits and experiences will be included as written in this itinerary, but could be on different days due to availability and schedules.
