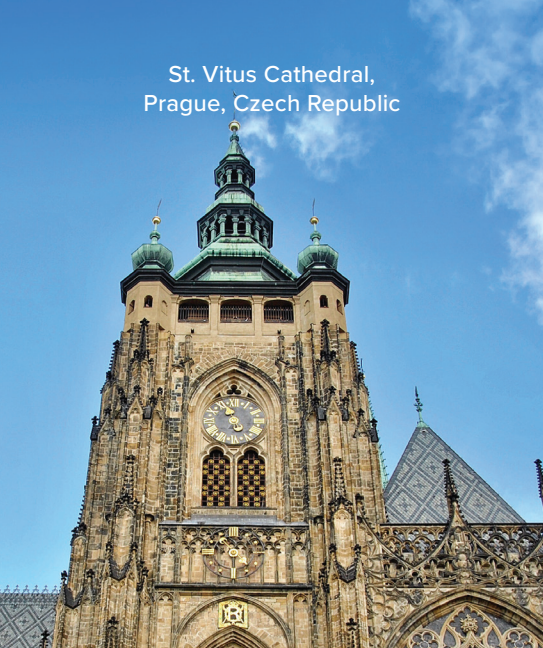

Later, take to the floor in a Viennese Waltz Dance Workshop and support the visually impaired community. DAY 4: ČESKÝ KRUMLOV, CZECH REPUBLIC - GOLDEN PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC After breakfast in the hotel, your group will check out and travel by private coach to Prague. Once over the Czech border, head for picturesque Český Krumlov, where you will begin with a brief orientation tour of this fairy-tale town, straight out of the Middle Ages. DAY 5: PRAGUE, CITY OF A HUNDRED SPIRES After breakfast at your hotel, explore Prague with your choice of your tour today. DAY 6: AUSCHWITZ, POLAND - KRAKÓW, POLAND After breakfast at your hotel, check out of your hotel and travel by motorcoach to Krakow, Poland. Enjoy a drive through the rolling Czech Countryside before crossing into Poland where you will stop at Oświęcim, better known by its German name of Auschwitz. Join a guided tour of the memorial and museum, which bore witness to the terrible atrocities of the Holocaust.

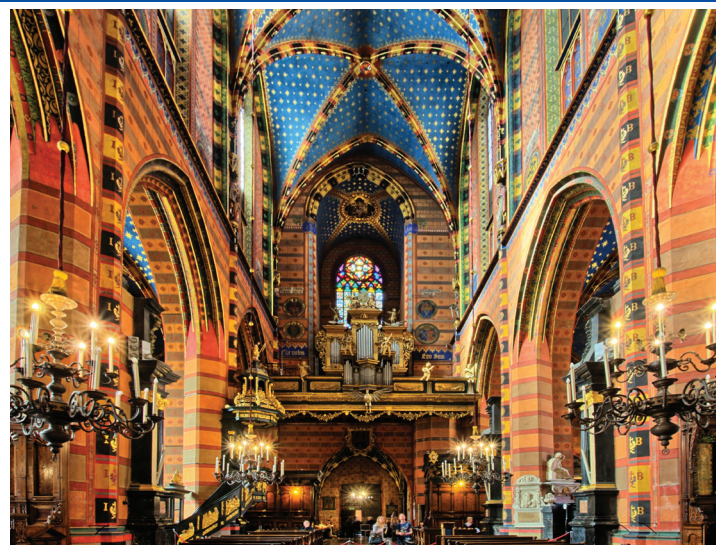
DAY 8: THROUGH SLEEPY SLOVAKIA TO BUDAPEST, HUNGARY

This agreement sets forth the terms and conditions under which we, IRTA Unique Journeys Presented by Boscov's Travel in return for payment of the amount indicated as the total price, agree to provide this tour.

Non-Refundable Deposit & Final Payment: A non-refundable deposit of \$300 per person is due with Reservation Form to secure reservations. Final payment Due Date is June 25, 2027.

Important General Information: The rate is based on a minimum of 30 paying participants.

Air Gateways: Roundtrip air transportation – including air taxes, government fees & current fuel surcharges (subject to increase at the discretion of the airline) – is included in the tour rate as listed. Air rates are ESTIMATED based on projected September/October 2027 air rates which are subject to change once actual September/October 2027 air rates are confirmed.

Name Changes: Name changes are not allowed. Each passenger cancellation is processed independently of any new passenger booking.

Hotel Accommodations: All accommodations are subject to availability and subject to change at the discretion of the tour operator.

Substitutions: Hotel substitutions may be necessary from time to time. If a component of the package, such as a visit or entertainment, should not be available, the tour operator has the right to substitute a component of equal or greater value.

Triple Rates: Triple room rate reduction is based on a standard double room with 2 beds. Triple rates do NOT include a third rollaway bed.

Required Travel Documentation: A VALID PASSPORT BOOK is required for tours that leave the United States and is the responsibility of each passenger. A passport card cannot be used for international air travel. Passport books should be valid for up to six (6) months beyond the return date of travel. All names must be submitted exactly as they appear on passenger passports. Dates of Birth (DOB's) are required with reservation for air travel. A clear and readable copy of passports is required. Additional forms may be necessary based on the destination.

Itinerary: Itinerary is subject to change. It's very common for the daily activities and people to people interactions & visits to be interchanged and experienced on different days than this printed itinerary. All visits and experiences will be included as written in this itinerary, but could be on different days due to availability and schedules.

Cancellation Policy & Fees: Initial deposit is non-refundable. For cancellations made between 94 days and 30 days prior to tour departure, 50% of the tour package cost will be assessed; in addition to any non-recoverable costs, including air. For cancellations made between 29 days and day of departure, 100% of the tour package cost will be assessed; in addition to any non-recoverable costs, including

air. Cancellations made DEPARTURE DAY/NO SHOWS will be subject to a 100% per person penalty, and will receive NO REFUND. Travel Protection plans are available to cover penalties for cancellations due to covered reasons.
