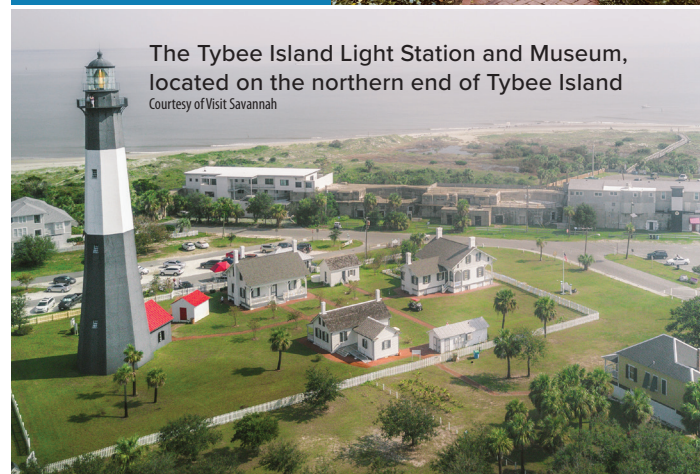

DAY 5: GOLDEN ISLES OF GEORGIA - ST. SIMONS, GA - JEKYLL ISLAND, GA

Following breakfast, you'll visit the Golden Isles of Georgia. Moss covered oaks and ocean breezes weave past and present together as your guide narrates stories from the days of pre-colonial, Colonial, Plantation and Timber Eras up to the present-day. Touring Ft. Frederica, you will step back in time to when brave Scots settlers and the British "regulars" and friendly natives, defeated the Spanish at the Battle of Bloody Marsh. Visit Christ Church, which traces its history back to John & Charles Wesley the founders of the Methodist Church. You'll have time for lunch and shopping at St. Simons Pier Village, site of the St. Simons Lighthouse. Later, travel to Jekyll Island where our tour begins with a stop at the former Club Stables, today the site of Mosaic Museum with exhibits from every era of Jekyll history. The tram tours through the historic district, decorated for Christmas, and highlights the times when Jekyll was the private winter home to an elite group of industrial magnates. It is a unique collection of architectural gems reflecting a revival of several European styles. Enjoy a delightful dinner at the Jekyll Island Club, a Victorian style hotel originally an exclusive retreat for the wealthy. DAY 6: TYBEE ISLAND, GA - JOURNEY HOME Following breakfast and check out, you will travel a short distance to Tybee Island, a charming coastal community and home to the Tybee Island Light Station and Museum. The Tybee Light Station has been guiding mariners' safe entrance into the Savannah River for over 285 years. After you visit here, you will have free time to shop and have lunch on your own before departing for the Savannah airport and your return flight home. 🍴 B

Deposit & Final Payment: Deposit of \$500 per person is due with Reservation Form to secure reservations. Final Payment Due Date is October 4, 2027.

Important General Information: The rate is based on a minimum of 30 paying participants.

Air Gateways: Roundtrip air transportation – including air taxes, government fees & current fuel surcharges (subject to increase at the discretion of the airline) – is included in the tour rate as listed. Air rates are ESTIMATED based on projected December 2027 air rates which are subject to change once actual December 2027 air rates are confirmed.

Name Changes are not allowed. Each passenger cancellation is processed independently of any new passenger booking.

Hotels are subject to change.

Triple Rates: Triple room rate reduction is based on a standard double room with 2 beds. Triple rates do NOT include a third rollaway bed.

Required Travel Documentation: For travel within the United States, beginning May 2025, a Real ID license or passport is required for air travel within the United States.

Itinerary: Itinerary is subject to change. It's very common for the daily activities and people to people interactions & visits to be interchanged and experienced on different days than this printed itinerary. All visits and experiences will be included as written in this itinerary, but could be on different days due to availability and schedules.

Cancellation Policy & Fees: Regardless of reason, cancellations are subject to the following assessments: For cancellations from October 5, 2027 to October 21, 2027 a cancellation fee of \$500 will be assessed plus any non-recoverable costs, including air. For cancellations on October 22, 2027 through November 5, 2027, a cancellation fee of 50% of the tour cost will be assessed plus any non-recoverable costs, including air. For cancellations on November 6, 2027, or later, a cancellation fee of 100% of the tour cost will be assessed plus any non-recoverable costs, including air. No refund will be given for No Shows. Travel Protection Plans are available to cover penalties due to covered reasons.

4. war or act of war, including invasion, acts of foreign enemies, hostilities between nations (whether declared or undeclared), or civil war;
5. the commission of or attempt to commit a felony or being engaged in an illegal occupation by You, a Traveling Companion, Family Member, or Business Partner;
