DAY 1: ARRIVE PORTLAND, MAINE

Arrive in Portland, Maine's largest city, sitting on a peninsula jutting out into beautiful island-filled Casco Bay. Meet your Tour Director and check into your hotel for an overnight stay.

Overnight: **Portland, ME**

DAY 2: PORTLAND - CASCO BAY CRUISE, MAINE - BAR HARBOR, MAINE

This morning, enjoy a scenic Casco Bay Cruise to see iconic New England lighthouses including America's most photographed, the Portland Head Lighthouse. Later, travel north and arrive in Bar Harbor and check into your hotel for a two-night stay. The town of Bar Harbor sits on Mount Desert Island along Maine's Frenchman Bay and serves as a gateway to the mountains and cliffs of neighboring Acadia National Park. Join your fellow travelers for a Welcome Dinner tonight at a local restaurant.

DAY 3: ACADIA NATIONAL PARK, MAINE

Today, visit and explore Acadia National Park. Maine's only national park was the first national park established east of the Mississippi River in 1916. Comprised of a cluster of islands on the jagged coast, Acadia features a variety of landscapes including granite-domed mountains, woodlands, lakes, ponds, and ocean shoreline. The diverse habitats provide striking scenery and make the park a haven for wildlife and plants with over 2,500 species combined. Make several scenic stops during your visit including Cadillac Mountain, which at 1,530-feet is the highest point on the U.S. Atlantic Coast, and Thunder Hole, a beautiful coastal stop. This afternoon, return to Bar Harbor for an evening at your own pace.

DAY 4: BAR HARBOR - QUEBEC CITY, CANADA

Begin a scenic journey north through the picturesque landscapes of Maine, enjoying sweeping views of forests, rivers, and small rural communities along the way. Stop for an included lunch in the village of West Forks. Continue across the border into Canada. Later, arrive in historic Quebec City for a two-night stay. Founded in 1608 by French explorer Samuel de Champlain, Quebec City is one of North America's oldest European

settlements and is celebrated for its charming cobblestone streets, French heritage, and the beautifully preserved fortified walls of Old Quebec. Enjoy the evening at leisure.

DAY 5: QUEBEC CITY Today, enjoy a Quebec City Tour introducing you to Old & New Quebec. See Old Quebec's Ramparts which constitute the only remaining fortified city walls in Canada or the U.S. Also see the Plains of Abraham, the famous Le Chateau Frontenac, and The Citadel. Later, visit the massive Montmorency Falls, the highest falls in Eastern Canada — 98-feet higher than Niagara Falls and one of the most popular attractions in the region. This evening, join your fellow travelers for dinner at a popular local restaurant in Quebec City.

DAY 6: VIA RAIL QUEBEC CITY TO MONTREAL, CANADA

This morning all aboard Canada's VIA Rail for the scenic 3-hour train ride from Quebec City to Montreal. Pass through agricultural fields and small towns of the St. Lawrence River Valley; cross the massive historic steel bridges over the St. Lawrence River near both cities. Arrive in Montreal, one of the world's five largest French-speaking cities, yet most residents are bilingual. Montreal hosted the 1976 Summer Olympics and played host to Expo 67, a very successful world's fair. This afternoon, enjoy a Montreal City Tour to see the Notre Dame Cathedral, St. Joseph's Oratory, Old Town, and a panoramic view of the city from atop Mount Royal. Later, maybe head out on your own for dinner at a local restaurant in Old Town.

DAY 7: MONTREAL - MT. WASHINGTON, NEW HAMPSHIRE

This morning, take in the scenic countryside as you travel south crossing the Canada-U.S. border into Vermont. Continue into the White Mountains of New Hampshire, one of the most picturesque regions in the Northeast. Arrive for a two-night stay at the historic Omni Mount Washington Resort & Spa, a magnificent grand hotel set against the dramatic backdrop of Mount Washington, the highest peak in the Northeast at 6,288-feet. Opened in 1902, this elegant resort is renowned for its striking red-roofed facade, sweeping verandas, and panoramic



mountain views. The property was the site of the landmark Bretton Woods Conference, where delegates from 44 nations met to establish the modern international financial system following World War II. Enjoy time to relax and explore the resort's beautiful grounds and historic setting.

DAY 8: KANCAMAGUS HIGHWAY, NEW HAMPSHIRE - MT. WASHINGTON COG RAIL, NEW HAMPSHIRE Today, sit back and relax as you experience one of New England's most spectacular scenic drives, the Kancamagus Highway. The 34-mile drive along NH Route 112 is a National Scenic Byway running from Lincoln to Conway and famous for spectacular views of rivers, covered bridges, and mountain scenery. Later, board the historic Mount Washington Cog Railway to climb to the top of Mount Washington. Enjoy breathtaking views during the three-hour experience aboard the world's first (1869) mountain climbing Cog Railway. Later, enjoy an elegant dinner at the Omni Mount Washington Resort & Spa with your fellow travelers.

DAY 9: WINNIPESAUKEE RAIL, NEW HAMPSHIRE - BOSTON, MASSACHUSETTS Travel south to the charming lakeside town of Meredith on the shores of beautiful Lake Winnepesaukee, the largest lake in New Hampshire. Board the nostalgic Winnepesaukee Scenic Railroad for a ride along the lake's shoreline. Traveling aboard vintage rail cars along a historic rail corridor, enjoy views of sparkling waters, wooded hillsides, and charming New England villages while learning about the region's railroad and resort history*. Then, head south through scenic New England landscapes into the historic Boston area for your final night. Enjoy a Farewell Dinner in Boston with your fellow travelers to share stories and memories of your travel experiences.

Deposit & Final Payment: Deposit of \$400 per person is due with Reservation Form to secure reservations. Final Payment Due Date is June 10, 2027.

Air Gateways: Roundtrip air transportation from Philadelphia is included in the tour rate as listed. Other gateways may be available and pricing may vary. Should you choose to do your own air (not with Premier World Discovery) you would become a land only client. Roundtrip airport/hotel transfers would not be included in your rate but can be purchased at an additional cost if travel is on the same day as the tour. Pre and Post stays would need to purchase transfers on their own.

Name Changes are not allowed. Each passenger cancellation is processed independently of any new passenger booking.

Hotels are subject to change.

Booking Discount: Make your final payment with cash, check or Boscov's Credit Card prior to the final payment due date and receive \$100 per person discount rate. The Booking Discount for passengers making their own air arrangements is \$50 per person.

Triple Rates: Triple room rate reduction is based on a standard double room with 2 beds. Triple rates do NOT include a third rollaway bed. Room configurations vary greatly Internationally.

Passport & Date of Birth Information: A VALID PASSPORT BOOK is required for tours that leave the United States even to Canada and is the responsibility of each passenger. All names must be submitted exactly as they appear on passenger passports. Dates of Birth (DOB's) are required with reservation for air travel. A clear and readable copy of passports is required. Additional forms may be necessary based on the destination.
